Words for Today, from 1968 (from Newsletter Newsletter)

For America, this marks the 50th anniversary of a turbulent year, which included high-profile assassinations, the Vietnam War and civil rights protests. Five decades on, turmoil still abounds.

May we take hope and inspiration from Robert Kennedy, who, on the night of Martin Luther King's death, replaced a presidential-campaign speech with these words:

"What we need in the United States is not division; ... not hatred; ... not violence and lawlessness, but ... love, and wisdom, and compassion toward one another; and a feeling of justice toward those who still suffer within our country, whether they be white or ... black."

Kennedy added: "We will have difficult times in the future. ... But the vast majority of white people and ... black people in this country want to live together ... and want justice for all human beings. ... Let's dedicate ourselves ... to tame the savageness of man and make gentle the life of this world ... and say a prayer for our country and for our people."



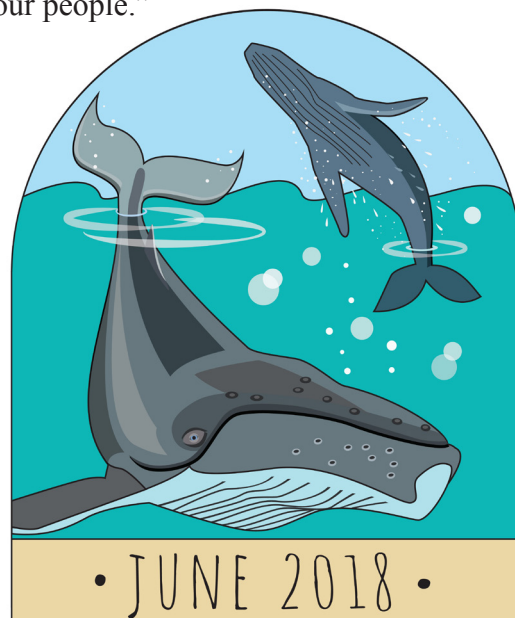

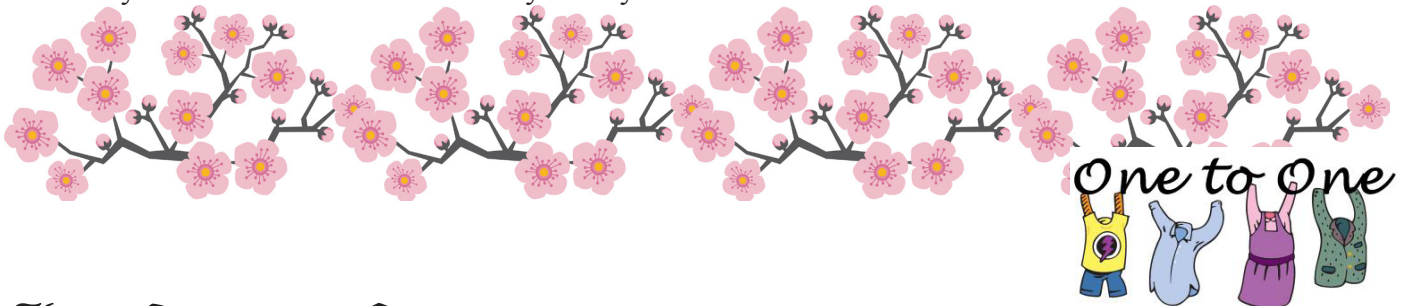


March Vestry Meeting Minutes

Next Vestry Meeting is June 24th



- Barb B— Senior Warden reported that the 2 trees were removed in preparation for the repairs. Mark C – made the Junior Warden Report
- Treasurer's Report - Doug P. discussed moving \$50,500 to an account from Key bank for the priest in charge salary. Discussion of moving all monies from Key bank to either Wright Patt Credit Union or Huntington Bank. Doug P. will research.
- Joyce G. made a motion that Doug open a Business Money Market Savings Account at Wright Patt Credit Union; Mark C. seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- Joyce G. made a motion that Doug move \$50,500 from general fund to the new Wright Patt account; Brad A. seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- Joyce G. made a motion that our \$6008.46 currently in Wright Patt Credit Union be moved to our new Wright Patt Credit Union account; Mark C. seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- Joyce G. made a motion that we update our signature cards at Wright Patt Credit Union, removing Summer Watts and Mike Taint, and adding Doug P. and Barb B. ; Cheryl E. seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- We're over budget on supply clergy and parish house. Any further repairs except for emergency needs to have vestry vote. There is only \$200-300 left in maintenance until we are over budget. We need to stop work on the sign.
- We are still waiting on applying for the grant. We need to fill out the application ASAP and submit the estimate for the kitchen remodel.
- Bradley A. informed about a moisture problem.
- Doug suggested that we write a letter that we request the Hager, Nybladh, and Williams money for church maintenance. Karen I. made a motion that we move the Hager, Nybladh, and Williams funds to our Memorial Money Market account; Brad A. seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- Brad A. reported on the A Abel bill for repairs and state of the air conditioner at the Parish House. Mark will check for more estimates.
- Joyce G. reported on landscape estimate on garden by the kitchen by Dean's Landscaping. \$3322. Prep work would be done in the summer, but sod should be put down in the fall. It would be difficult to keep Hydrangeas and Taxis bushes. He would remove tree stump; level it out.
- Karen I. reported the search committee for priest assembled; Karen I. reported on procedures and they are almost ready to contact the diocese. Canon Lynn was promoted to Ordinary and is going on sabbatical.
- bDoug P. requested that we please add Mark C. and Barbara B. to use the discretionary account in the absence of the priest. Joyce G. made a motion to allow Mark. C. and Barbara B. to use the discretionary account as needed in the absence of the priest; Brad A. seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- Posting of CECX information - ONLINE by unauthorized person or persons. Barbara B. volunteered to have Becky G. send an announcement that if webpages or e-communications need updating to **CON**tact Becky G. or Tanya E-K.
- Cheryl E. reported Church picnic at the Thomas' on July 1st.
- Vestry decided there will be no Vestry in July.

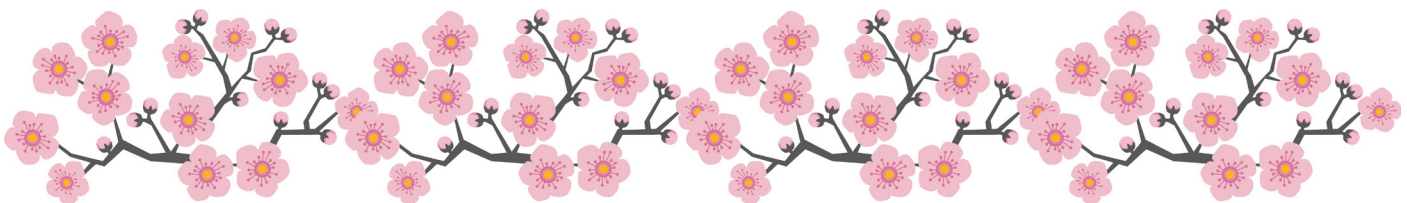
