Vestry tonight agreed that we will plan to return to communal worship on Sunday, August 9th. We'll have to keep our eyes on the Ohio Public Health Advisory System's COVID-19 chart that the state of Ohio puts out. So long as we are a level 1 or 2 we are good to go. Rev. Jen is working with Brad and Jim about the particulars and we will keep you informed.
